### Important:

Do not pack the waste in paper or plastic bags, but put it loose in the green paper garbage can, otherwise it cannot be sorted.

### Important:

Do not pack organic waste in plastic bags, including compostable plastic bags. Paper bags or newspaper is acceptable for packaging. Plastic packaging and nets must be removed and belong in the yellow LVP bin.

## Blue glass bin

Glass bottles for e.g. perfume  
Glass bottles for wine, champagne, spirits, vinegar, oil, etc.  
Pickle jars

### Important:

Only empty glass packaging should be disposed of, lids do not have to be unscrewed.
